Gear List



Bedding

1x pillow
1x sleeping bag OR
1x blanket & sheets

Shoes

2 x pairs min (at least 1 pair sneakers or covered shoes suitable for walking and climbing activities, and one pair that can get wet for confidence course. Crocs and jandals **are not** suitable for this activity but may be worn around the camp site).

Toilet Gear (all in a toilet bag)

Toothbrush/toothpaste
3 x towels
Face cloth
Shampoo
Soap (in a container)
Deodorant- NO SPRAY ON, roll on only (optional)
Hairbrush/spare hair ties (if necessary)
Plastic bag for wet towel

Medical Kit (in container)

Insect repellent - non-aerosol (it triggers the fire alarms) - pump/spray fine
Sunscreen - non-aerosol
Lip balm (optional)
Torch with new batteries- **compulsory**

Clothing

5 x sets of underwear
4 x T-shirts
2 x sweatshirts/warm jumper
3 x shorts
1 x waterproof jacket
Old clothes for mudslide & confidence course
2 x long pants
4 x pairs of socks
Pyjamas
Swimming togs
Sun hat

4 plastic bags for storing dirty/wet clothes

Pencil case

Kitchen Utensils

1 x tea towel

Refillable water bottle

Cup

Optional Extras

Book to read

Skipping rope

Soft toy

Frisbee

Blind fold (for Burma Trail)

Pack of cards

Baking/Biscuits/Fruit: Each child needs to bring one of these options for morning & afternoon teas. Due to some children having allergies, **NO NUTS PLEASE**. Please label other common allergens, such as egg & dairy. These are to be handed in on arrival at school on camp day and will be shared out for morning/afternoon tea each day. (No fresh bananas, please).

ANY MEDICATION MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH CHILD'S NAME, NAME OF MEDICATION AND DOSAGE, INSIDE A SEALED ZIP-LOCK BAG OR CONTAINER AND HANDED TO JULIET (in the office) THE END OF TERM 1 - receiving these on Monday morning before we leave will be too difficult.

Students will need to bring their morning tea, lunch and their drink bottle for the first day of camp in their backpack. Baking/biscuits/fruit should also be in this bag.

Things not to take:

NO money, gum, lollies, chips, radios, jibbitz, phones, any devices.

NO jewellery, other than watches and small earring studs, should be worn at camp.
